

# Legacy Sabers Fastpitch Softball Booster Club Meeting Minutes

## 1. Call to Order

- Meeting was called to order by President, Jackie Freborg, at 7:00 p.m.

## 3. Approval of Minutes

- The minutes from the January 13, 2025, meeting were reviewed. Danielle made a motion to approve, which was seconded by Beth.

## 4. Treasurer's Report

- Tena presented the treasurer's report.
  - BNC Account balance is \$9,989.23
  - School Account balance is \$2,212.06
- **Sponsorship Updates**
  - The 2026 sponsorship form is available on the Website under the Boosters Tab.
  - Tena reported that we have a goal of \$8,200 for sponsorships. We currently have brought in \$2,800.
  - Piper and Riley will attend The Moose meeting on February 16, 2026, at 6:45 PM to ask for a sponsorship. They will bring a few underclassmen with them.

## 5. Agenda Items

- **Coach Request Updates**
  - Jackie reported that a new set of catcher's gear was purchased for the team by the district.
  - Tena reported that the weighted total control balls were purchased and delivered.
  - Tena reported that she has not paid for Game Changer yet but will check with Coach Elgie about getting the login to pay for it. Coach said the cost is \$450 for this year.
  - Tena reported that the Dome has been reserved for several practices as requested by coach: Monday, March 16, from 9:00–11:00 AM; Saturday, March 21, from 2:00–4:00 PM; and Monday, March 23, from 7:15–9:00 PM.

- **300 – Hour Club Apparel**
  - Beth talked to the Basketball boosters about their jackets. The cost is about \$128 to purchase from Scheels. It was suggested to look into purchasing jackets and embroidery from The Locker Room / Mitchel @ Northern Trophy. Danielle will check further into availability and prices from them.
  - It was decided that only jackets will be purchased this year for the 300-Hour Club, not T-shirts. The idea was also discussed to provide a T-shirt along with embroidery on the jacket in future years for those who complete 300 hours after already receiving a jacket.
  
- **Crewnecks**
  - \$2,000 total budget for the crewnecks (\$50 x 40 girls)
  - Jackie reported that everything is in place to order the crewnecks once the teams are established. The crewnecks will be black with a white name and number on the back. She was told the turnaround should only be 2 weeks.
  
- **Timed Raffle**
  - The Timed Raffle drawings will take place on May 3<sup>rd</sup> with the location and exact times to be determined. We will possibly plan to have a team dinner that night.
  - Beth and Danielle have all the drawing times and amounts planned out with the big winners being on the hour. There will be 25 prizes totaling \$1500.
  - Beth will use United Printing to have the tickets made. It was decided to have 600 tickets printed.
  - Each player will be given 10 tickets to start with and can get more.
  - The tickets will be sold for \$20 each.
  
- **Photography**
  - Tena reported that Photos by Rip will cover the season again. He requested that we let him know any specific theme nights or dates of interest. He will provide a monetary discount as a sponsorship. He will produce the end-of-season banquet video for \$125. If services are the same as last year, the total cost will be \$1,085, which includes coverage of three varsity nights (six games) and two nights (four games) each for JV1 and JV2. Tena will request the selected varsity dates and will provide JV1 and JV2 dates once schedules are finalized and the best options are determined.

Senior Night – May 7
  
- **Banners**
  - Tena is in contact with United Printing regarding the previously approved banner order: four banners total—one for each team and one featuring the seniors.
  
- **Hotel Block**
  - It was discussed that a block of hotel rooms should be reserved in Williston for the WDA tournament. The team will stay at the Hawthorn Suites. It was decided to reserve 24 rooms for Thursday and Friday nights at a nearby, different hotel. Danielle will call to reserve a block of rooms.
  
- **Green / Mental Health Awareness night** (Thursday, April 2<sup>nd</sup> vs. Mandan)
  - The senior girls plan to give all of the players a green ribbon to wear for the game.

- **Teacher Appreciation Night** (Tuesday, April 14<sup>th</sup> vs. Minot)
  - Jackie will ask Piper to help make a Google form for the girls to fill out for Teacher Appreciate Night.
  
- **BYFSA Youth Night** (Tuesday, April 21<sup>st</sup> vs. Century – Century is home)
  
- **Military Night** (Tuesday, April 28<sup>th</sup> vs. BHS)
  - Beth and Danielle presented possible Military Jersey options. Beth found a \$20 Dri-Fit t-shirt option, while Danielle noted that BSN only offered a men's fit jersey for \$38. Mitch at Northern Trophy, who has printed jerseys in the past, has not yet responded to Danielle. BriAnne made a motion to proceed with purchasing from Capital Trophy at \$29.75 per jersey for a no-pill, no-snag option in a women's fit. It was decided to order 36 new military jerseys to align with the numbers on the current jerseys. Tena stated that, if necessary, additional funds from equipment and raffle sales could cover the additional apparel costs. The motion was approved and Danielle will move forward with getting the military jerseys ordered.
  - Kim is still waiting for a call back from the National Guard. She will continue to try to contact them to have a presence at the game. We would like to follow through with their offer of having a team photo taken at the National Guard building.
  
- **Senior Night** (Thursday, May 7<sup>th</sup> vs. Watford City)
  - It was noted that the game against Watford City for Senior Night will be held on Thursday, May 7, rather than Wednesday, May 6, as previously thought.
  
- **Parent Meeting** – March 9<sup>th</sup> at 6:00-7:00 in the Legacy Auditorium
  - A few of the board members should be there about 5:00 or 5:30 to set up. We will have a table outside of the Auditorium where players/parents can pay for booster fees and raffle tickets (if they do not want to sell them).
  - It was decided to create an envelope for each player that will include the need-to-know form, raffle tickets, sponsorship forms, and possibly a cooler FYI sheet.
  - Danielle will add to the need-to-know form that the player who sells the most raffle tickets and the player who brings in the highest amount in sponsorships will each receive a \$100 Scheels or Dick's gift card.
  - Beth will label the raffle tickets ahead of time.
  - Jackie will prepare a speech that will include information like what the boosters pay for, raffle tickets, the coolers, how to get your booster fee waived by getting sponsorships of \$200 or more, etc.
  - Jackie will have a form for parents to fill in their name, phone number, and e-mail address.
  
- **Coolers**
  - BriAnne volunteered to take lead in creating the cooler schedule and updating it on Sports You.
  - The Liudahls are currently storing two coolers in their shop. Jackie has a third cooler at her house that she will donate.

## 6. New Business

- **Thank You Cards**

- Tena and Jackie shared examples of photo thank-you cards and suggested having some made to send to sponsors and raffle ticket winners. Photo cards can be printed online at a reasonable cost, and the girls can either write a short note or sign them. Everyone agreed this was a great idea and that it is something we should do. Tena hand wrote thank you cards last year.
- It was suggested that one large team photo be taken of all three teams together in their Military Jerseys and jeans to use for the thank-you card.
- Jackie will ask Heather if she would be interested and able to take the photo for us. There were several other suggestions for photographers if Heather cannot help.
- Danielle or Jackie will talk to Coach about finding time to take the photo.

- **Future Fundraising**

- Kim stated that her husband, Jeremy, remains very interested in helping organize a fundraising raffle for next year, including applying for a deer tag. The basketball team held a very successful fundraiser this year using high ticket items such as a Blackstone grill, boots, and a gaming tag. The group will keep this for New Business and revisit the topic toward the end of the season.
- She even suggested a high-ticket item, such as an ATV, but noted that we would need to have the funds available to cover the purchase upfront.

## 7. Announcements

- The next meeting is scheduled for Wednesday, March 4, at 6:00 PM at Evette's house to assemble the player envelopes for the parent meeting. An additional meeting is scheduled for Tuesday, March 24, at 7:00 PM at Wing City.
